With a remarkable **34 years of teaching experience** at undergraduate, postgraduate, M.Phil, and Ph.D levels, Dr. Naik has contributed significantly to higher education across Odisha, Chhattisgarh, and Jharkhand. His academic career began in 1991 as a Lecturer in Education at I.M.P.S. College, Sundargarh, Odisha.
